### TWENTY-SEVENTH ANNUAL FALL FOOD & WINE FESTIVAL SET FOR OCTOBER 30

Each October, Pasadenans look forward to the annual Fall Food & Wine Festival, held on the festive grounds between the Parkway Grill and the Arroyo Chop House in Pasadena. Co-produced by Parkway Grill owners Gregg and Bob Smith and Huntington Memorial Hospital, event proceeds benefit the hospital's Center for Trauma Care and will ensure Huntington Hospital's trauma services receive the support needed to operate the only trauma center in the San Gabriel Valley.

Thanks to community donations and the proceeds from the Fall Food & Wine event, the hospital was able to close the capital campaign, raising the entire \$80 million required to complete the expansion project, that will double the size of the existing emergency facility. "The support we received from our donors and the Fall Food & Wine sponsors over the past several years was remarkable," said Jane Haderlein, senior vice president of external affairs. "We know how important trauma care is to the families of Pasadena and, when complete, the new facility will offer highly advanced trauma treatment in a state-of-the-art environment." The project is scheduled for completion in 2013.

This year Linda Barker and Garrett Bell will once again be our event chairs and promise a spectacular offering of sumptuous wines and delicious specialties to sample.
